Howard Area Community Center - A Multi-service organization serving low income individuals and families in Rogers Park

Connections for the Homeless - Serves homeless adults/families and those threatened with homelessness

Night Ministry - Connects with vulnerable youth/adults through street outreach, youth shelter and support services, etc.

REST - Residents in Effective Shelter Transitions. - Provides shelter, permanent housing and social service

Greater Chicago Food Depository - Nonprofit food distribution & training center providing food while striving to end hunger in our community

Chicago Coalition for the Homeless - Organize and advocate to prevent and end homelessness--a human right in a just society

Northside Anti-Hunger Network - Coalition of food security agencies supporting the operations of member agencies in responding to the hunger needs of our community

Illinois Hunger Coalition - Seeks to alleviate and end hunger and the underlying causes through community organizing, advocating for progressive public policies, and public education
